

NAME

Blt_TreeName – Returns the name of the tree data object.

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <bltTree.h>
```

```
char *
```

```
Blt_TreeName(tree)
```

ARGUMENTS

Blt_Tree *tree* (in) Token for the tree object.

DESCRIPTION

This procedure returns the name of the C-based tree data object. The arguments are as follows:

tree Token for the tree object. The token must have been previously obtained via **Blt_TreeGetToken** or **Blt_TreeCreate**.

RETURNS

The name of the tree object is returned. The name will be fully qualified with a namespace context.

EXAMPLE

The following example prints the name of the new tree.

```
Blt_Tree token;

if (Blt_TreeCreate(interp, NULL, &token) != TCL_OK) {
    return TCL_ERROR;
}
printf("tree is %s\n", Blt_TreeName(token));
```
