CREATE_GROUP – define a new database role

SYNOPSIS

CREATE GROUP *name* [[WITH] *option* [...]]

where *option* can be:

SUPERUSER | NOSUPERUSER
| CREATEDB | NOCREATEDB
| CREATEROLE | NOCREATEROLE
| INHERIT | NOINHERIT
| LOGIN | NOLOGIN
| REPLICATION | NOREPLICATION
| BYPASSRLS | NOBYPASSRLS
| CONNECTION LIMIT *connlimit*
| [ENCRYPTED] PASSWORD '*password*' | PASSWORD NULL
| VALID UNTIL '*timestamp*'
| IN ROLE *role_name* [, ...]
| IN GROUP *role_name* [, ...]
| ROLE *role_name* [, ...]
| ADMIN *role_name* [, ...]
| USER *role_name* [, ...]
| SYSID *uid*

DESCRIPTION

CREATE GROUP is now an alias for CREATE ROLE (**CREATE_ROLE(7)**).

COMPATIBILITY

There is no **CREATE GROUP** statement in the SQL standard.
