

NAME

`auparse_flush_feed` – flush any unconsumed feed data through parser.

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <auparse.h>
```

```
int auparse_flush_feed(auparse_state_t *au);"
```

DESCRIPTION

auparse_flush_feed should be called to signal the end of feed input data and flush any pending parse data through the parsing system.

RETURN VALUE

Returns `-1` if an error occurs; otherwise, `0` for success.
