

NAME

barcode – draws a random sequence of barcodes for the products you enjoy

SYNOPSIS

barcode [--display *host:display.screen*] [--visual *visual*] [--window] [--root] [--window-id *number*]
[--delay *number*] [--clock] [--clock24] [--fps]

DESCRIPTION

This draws a random sequence of colorful barcodes scrolling across your screen.

OPTIONS

--**visual** *visual*

Specify which visual to use. Legal values are the name of a visual class, or the id number (decimal or hex) of a specific visual.

--**window**

Draw on a newly-created window. This is the default.

--**root** Draw on the root window.

--**window-id** *number*

Draw on the specified window.

--**delay** *number*

Per-frame delay, in microseconds. Default: 10000 (0.02 seconds.).

--**clock** Instead of drawing a stream of barcodes, draw a barcode-based digital clock.

--**clock24**

Same as --clock, but display 24-hour time instead of 12-hour time.

--**fps** Display the current frame rate and CPU load.

ENVIRONMENT**DISPLAY**

to get the default host and display number.

XENVIRONMENT

to get the name of a resource file that overrides the global resources stored in the RESOURCE_MANAGER property.

XSCREENSAVER_WINDOW

The window ID to use with --root.
