

NAME

compass – draws a spinning compass.

SYNOPSIS

compass [--display *host:display.screen*] [--visual *visual*] [--window] [--root] [--window-id *number*]
[--delay *number*] [--no-db] [--fps]

DESCRIPTION

This draws a compass, with all elements spinning about randomly, for that “lost and nauseous” feeling.

OPTIONS

--**visual** *visual*

Specify which visual to use. Legal values are the name of a visual class, or the id number (decimal or hex) of a specific visual.

--**window**

Draw on a newly-created window. This is the default.

--**root** Draw on the root window.

--**window-id** *number*

Draw on the specified window.

--**delay** *number*

Per-frame delay, in microseconds. Default: 20000 (0.02 seconds.).

--**db** | --**no-db**

Double Buffer. Boolean.

--**fps** Display the current frame rate and CPU load.

ENVIRONMENT**DISPLAY**

to get the default host and display number.

XENVIRONMENT

to get the name of a resource file that overrides the global resources stored in the RESOURCE_MANAGER property.

XSCREENSAVER_WINDOW

The window ID to use with --root.
