

NAME

curl_easy_reset – reset all options of a libcurl session handle

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
void curl_easy_reset(CURL *handle);
```

DESCRIPTION

Re-initializes all options previously set on a specified curl handle to the default values. This puts back the handle to the same state as it was in when it was created with *curl_easy_init(3)*.

It does not change the following information kept in the handle: live connections, the Session ID cache, the DNS cache, the cookies, the shares or the alt-svc cache.

PROTOCOLS

This functionality affects all supported protocols

EXAMPLE

```
int main(void)
{
    CURL *curl = curl_easy_init();
    if(curl) {

        /* ... the handle is used and options are set ... */
        curl_easy_reset(curl);
    }
}
```
