

NAME

curl_multi_strerror – return string describing error code

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
const char *curl_multi_strerror(CURLMcode errornum);
```

DESCRIPTION

This function returns a string describing the *CURLMcode* error code passed in the argument *errornum*.

PROTOCOLS

This functionality affects all supported protocols

EXAMPLE

```
int main(void)
{
    int still_running;
    CURLM *multi = curl_multi_init();

    CURLMcode mresult = curl_multi_perform(multi, &still_running);
    if(mresult)
        printf("error: %s\n", curl_multi_strerror(mresult));
}
```

AVAILABILITY

Added in curl 7.12.0

RETURN VALUE

A pointer to a null-terminated string.
