

NAME

`dblink_disconnect` – closes a persistent connection to a remote database

SYNOPSIS

`dblink_disconnect()` returns text

`dblink_disconnect(text connname)` returns text

DESCRIPTION

`dblink_disconnect()` closes a connection previously opened by **`dblink_connect()`**. The form with no arguments closes an unnamed connection.

ARGUMENTS

connname

The name of a named connection to be closed.

RETURN VALUE

Returns status, which is always OK (since any error causes the function to throw an error instead of returning).

EXAMPLES

```
SELECT dblink_disconnect();
```

dblink_disconnect

```
SELECT dblink_disconnect('myconn');
```
