

NAME

dracut-catimages – creates initial ramdisk image by concatenating images

SYNOPSIS

dracut-catimages [*OPTION...*] *<initramfs base image>* [*<image>...*]

DESCRIPTION

dracut-catimages creates an initial ramdisk image by concatenating several images from the command line and /var/lib/dracut/images/*.img

OPTIONS

-f, --force

overwrite existing initramfs file.

-i, --imagedir

Directory with additional images to add (default: /var/lib/dracut/images/)

-o, --overlaydir

Overlay directory, which contains additional files that will be used to create an additional image

--nooverlay

Do not use the overlay directory

--noimagedir

Do not use the additional image directory

-h, --help

display help text and exit.

--debug

output debug information of the build process

-v, --verbose

verbose output during the build process

/var/lib/dracut/images/*.img
