

NAME

elf32_offscn – retrieve a section descriptor by file offset for a 32-bit ELF file

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <libelf.h>
```

```
Elf_Scn *elf32_offscn(Elf *elf, off_t offset);
```

DESCRIPTION

The **elf32_offscn** function retrieves the section descriptor for the non-empty section at the specified file offset in the ELF32 object referred to by *elf*.

PARAMETERS

elf An *Elf* pointer to the ELF object from which the section descriptor is to be retrieved.

offset An *off_t* value representing the file offset of the section whose descriptor is to be retrieved.

RETURN VALUE

The **elf32_offscn** function returns a pointer to the *Elf_Scn* of the non-empty section with a *sh_offset* matching *offset*. If an error occurs, it returns NULL and sets an appropriate libelf error code.
