

NAME

`audit_name_to_errno`, `audit_errno_to_name` – Convert the errno name and the numeric errno value to each other

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <libaudit.h>
```

```
int audit_name_to_errno(const char *error);
```

```
const char *audit_errno_to_name(int error);
```

DESCRIPTION

`audit_name_to_errno()` converts the errno name ("EPERM", "ENOENT", "ESRCH", etc.) to the numeric errno value (EPERM, ENOENT, ESRCH, etc.). *error* is the errno name.

`audit_errno_to_name()` converts the numeric errno value (EPERM, ENOENT, ESRCH, etc.) to the errno name ("EPERM", "ENOENT", "ESRCH", etc.). *error* is the numeric errno value.

RETURN VALUE

`audit_name_to_errno()` returns 0 if an error occurs; otherwise, the return value is the numeric errno value.

`audit_errno_to_name()` returns NULL if an error occurs; otherwise, the return value is the errno name.
